



Hillcrest Event Bartending

JOB DESCRIPTION

The Hillcrest Business Association produces six community events annually in the 92103 area. Events range from street fairs to self-guided food tours in the neighborhood. We are looking for experienced hospitality individuals who have a strong connection to Hillcrest and would like to pick up extra bar shifts at our neighborhood bar festivals. If this sounds like something you are interested in please submit cover letter, resume with references and events that you are available for scheduling.

Title: Bartender

Reports to: Bar Manager and Event Director

Job tasks:

- Take beverage orders from guests and servers.
- Ensure festival safety standards and liquor laws are obeyed.
- Prepare and serve alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks consistent with the festival's standard drink recipes.
- Record drink orders accurately and immediately after receipt into the register system.
- Accept guest payment, process credit card charges and make change (if applicable).
- Prepare garnishes for drinks and replenish bar snacks (if applicable)
- Maintains bottles and glasses in an attractive and functional manner to support efficient drink preparation and promotion of beverages.
- Clear and reset tables in bar area.
- Present drink menus, make recommendations and answer questions regarding beverages.
- Maintain cleanliness in all areas of the bar including tables, utensils, and storage areas.
- Report all equipment problems and bar maintenance issues to bar manager.
- Assist the restocking and replenishment of bar inventory and supplies.
- Be available to fill in as needed to ensure the smooth and efficient operation of the bar as directed by the bar manager or immediate supervisor.
- Attempt to limit problems and liability related to customers' excessive drinking by taking steps such as persuading customers to stop drinking, or ordering taxis or other transportation for intoxicated patrons.
- Must breakdown bar areas before shift ends.

Qualifications:

Must currently work at bar or restaurant establishment from the following locations: Urban Mo's, Baja Betty's, Hillcrest Brewing Company, Gossip Girl, Fiesta Cantina, Uptown Tavern,

Be 21 years of age. Minimum of 1 year of bartending and/or serving experience required. Possess a current California Food Handler Card for the County of San Diego.

Must be friendly, outgoing, and act in a professional manner in a festival environment.

Be able to communicate and understand the predominant language(s) of our guests.

Have working knowledge of beer, wine and liquor and common drink recipes.

Possess basic math skills and have the ability to handle money and operate a cash register.

Be able to work in a standing position for long periods of time (up to 6 hours).

Qualified candidates only. Please send us your resume for the Bartending position.

Compensation:

Bartenders are volunteers and will be compensated for event services through a tipping pool. Upon completion of shift, bartender will check in with Bar Manager to make sure area is covered. Bar Manager will collect tips from bar areas and distribute to staff when festival has ended. Bartenders with early closing shifts will receive tip payment from organizer at a later scheduled date.

Failure to comply with any of these standards will result in loss of tips as decided by the Bar Manager or any supervisor. No exceptions.
